

Fraudulent Email Address Alert

16 November 2018, Hong Kong – Industrial and Commercial Bank of China (Asia) Limited (“ICBC (Asia)” or “the Bank”) would like to alert all customers and the public to fraudulent emails with the suffix “@icbcasian.com”. The Bank has no connection with the fraudulent emails and the official suffix for the Bank’s email address is “@icbcasia.com”. The Bank urges the public not to provide any personal data to such fraudulent email address.

The Bank has reported the above case to the Hong Kong Police and the Hong Kong Monetary Authority, and will take necessary and appropriate action to protect the reputation of the Bank and the interests of the customers and the public.

Anyone who has provided personal information to such fraudulent email address should report to the Police immediately for investigation.
