Web Browser

 Do not save your credit card information on web browsers such as Chrome, Firefox and Safari.



Public Internet

 Never use your credit card to make online payment when connecting to public internet networks.



SMS

 If you receive an SMS notification of a credit card payment that you did not make, please contact the Bank immediately.



Credit Card Information

• Do not share your credit card information and Card Verification Value (CVV) with anyone.

Always ensure that the website is secure - The URL should begin with https:// and have a green padlock icon in front.





Do not make credit card payments on insecure websites and online merchants. On secure websites, there should always be the Verified by VISA sign or SMS OTP system to authorize every transaction.
