Visa payWave is a fast and convenient way to pay for everyday purchases. It is a secure, contactless chip technology designed to make payments easier.

Is this technology secure?

The Visa payWave platform is based on secure EMV chip technology, which provides both data protection and transaction security via the use of keys and the latest encryption technology. Visa payWave transactions are processed through the same, reliable payment network as EMV chip transactions.

Is there a limit on the value of the goods you can purchase with Visa payWave technology?

There is no limit of the value of goods that you can purchase with your Visa payWave Card. For purchases below S\$100, just wave your Card and no signature is required. For purchases above S\$100, the Card will need to be inserted into the Card terminal or waved in front of the terminal, and your signature or PIN will be required to validate the transaction.

Can I unknowingly make a purchase if I walk past the reader?

No. Visa payWave is designed to ensure that the Cardholder is always in control. The retailer must first have entered the purchase amount for approval and your Card has to be held in very close proximity to the Card reader (within 4cm) for more than half a second in order for a transaction to take place. Terminals can also only process one payment transaction at a time.

What is Visa payWave?

This contactless payment technology gives you the option to pay faster with your Visa Card.

How to pay with Visa payWave

STEP 1



Look for the Visa payWave mark and contactless logo at the point of sale.

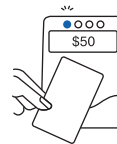


STEP 2



The cashier enters your purchase amount into the terminal. This amount will be displayed on the Visa payWave reader.

STEP 3



Once the blue light blinks, hold your Card over the reader at close range (less than 4cm from where the contactless logo appears).

STEP 4



The yellow light indicates that your Card is being read and processed. Do not remove your Card when the yellow light is on.

STEP 5



Once the transaction is completed, you have the option of getting a printed receipt.
