## ICBC (Asia) Branch Service Updates

2 March 2022, Hong Kong – In view of the latest development of COVID-19 epidemic and customers' need for banking service, Industrial and Commercial Bank of China (Asia) Limited ("ICBC (Asia)" or the "Bank") announced that its branch services will be adjusted as follows until further notice.

## I. The services of the following additional branches are adjusted from today (2 March):

### II. Service suspension related to COVID-19 confirmed cases:

The branch has been temporarily closed from 25 February 2022 (Friday) until further notice.

The Bank has arranged thorough cleaning and disinfection at the above branches, as well as the employees who have been in close contact with the related staff members to take COVID-19 tests. They are required to obtain negative test results before returning to work. The Bank will continue to closely monitor the situation, and maintain close liaison with the Centre for Health Protection, to fully support the government's epidemic prevention work. It will also provide appropriate assistance to its staff.

## III. Banking hours at all branches and Personal Banking Centres

The banking hours at all ICBC (Asia) branches and Personal Banking Centres continue to be adjusted to 9 am to 4 pm from Mondays to Fridays. From 5 March 2022, all branches and Personal Banking Centres will be suspended on Saturdays until further notice.
